

CODES OF CONDUCT FOR SENIOR MEMBERS

The club believes that it is important that members, committee, coaches administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the welfare of others.

As an adult member of the club, you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members should take responsibility to ensure that they are up-to-date with club rules and practice and adhere to them.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all others in the club and of visitors to it. This is regardless of age, gender, race, religion, sexual identity or cultural background.
- Members should recognise and respect the valuable contribution made by coaches, staff and other volunteers. In particular, new coaches should be supported in their initiatives and work within the club.
- All members should treat other players, members, club staff and officials with the same level of respect they would expect to be shown themselves. Bullying or harassment will not be tolerated.
- Members' conduct should set an example to junior club members.
- Members should pay subscriptions and any other fees incurred on time.
- Members should aim to create a positive atmosphere by "talking up" the club, both within the club itself and outside. In particular, new members and visitors should be made welcome socially and in sport.
- Members should feel able to raise any concerns they have with an appropriate committee member or member of staff. This should be done on a basis of respect.
